

Health and Safety Policy Statement

This is the Health and Safety Policy Statement of **Cairngorms Orchestra** in accordance with the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974.

Our statement of general policy is:

- to provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities;
- to consult with members of the Committee and volunteers on matters affecting their health and safety;
- to provide information, instruction and supervision for members and volunteers.
- to ensure all members and volunteers are competent to do their tasks, and to give them adequate training;
- to prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health;
- to maintain safe and healthy working conditions;
- to review and revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals.

Overall and final responsibility for health and safety and for the day-to-day actions and arrangements for putting this policy into practice lies with Cairngorms Orchestra.

Actions/arrangements:

- Relevant risk assessments to be completed and actions arising out of those assessments to be implemented. (Risk assessments to be reviewed when working habits or conditions change.)
- Members and volunteers to be given necessary health and safety induction and provided with appropriate training
- Members and volunteers to be routinely consulted on health and safety matters as they arise.

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
